In the early Church, *catechumen* was the name applied to one who had not yet been initiated into the sacred mysteries, but was undergoing a course of preparation for that purpose. When the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) was revised following Vatican II, those seeking the sacraments of initiation who had never been baptized were still called catechumens. Those who had been baptized and were seeking Eucharist and Confirmation were called candidates.
